The Alumni has been formed as a non-profit organization, and shall exist for the purpose of promoting and establishing good fellowship among our members to exemplify the spirit of loyalty and patriotism toward the organization, and to support the various activities of the Red Hussar Alumni.

There shall be four classifications of membership:

1. Active

- ♦ Any former Red Hussar
- ♦ Shall have voting rights and privileges
- ♦ Shall pay dues of \$25.00 per year
- ♦ Shall receive the RHAA newsletter

2. Associate

- ♦ Any interested person wishing to be a supporter of the alumni
- ♦ Shall not have voting rights or privileges
- ♦ Shall pay dues of \$15.00 per year
- ♦ Shall receive the RHAA newsletter

3. Sustaining

- ♦ Any persons or entity desiring to make monetary contributions and/or support to the RHAA
- ♦ Shall not have voting rights or privileges
- ♦ Shall receive the RHAA newsletter with a minimum of \$15.00 contribution

4. Honorary

- ♦ Any person chosen by the RHAA honored by this designation
- ♦ Shall not have voting rights or privileges
- ♦ Shall not pay dues

The fiscal year shall be from June 1st through May 31st of the following year. All persons wishing to be members of the RHAA shall be required to complete a membership application and submit appropriate dues at that time. The fully assessed dues per classification must accompany an application submitted during any fiscal year. The dues or contributions collected will be used for but not inclusive to the following:

- ♦ Rental for post office box
- Rental for instrument storage and meeting facilities
- Purchase and maintenance of instruments
- ♦ All costs incurred for printing and mailing of newsletters, membership applications, and all other clerical needs
- All expenses incurred for participation in social activities as voted on by the RHAA.
